# 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

DATE: The Championship is being held on 5-9 September 2025

PLACE: 3-1 Yoyogi Kamizonocho, Shibuya-ku, Tokyo;

Youth Education National Olympics Memorial Youth Center in Yoyogi, Tokyo, Japan.

## 2. NATIONAL TEAM COMPOSITION and CHAMPIONSHIP DISCIPLINES

- The National Teams have four players: one Man, one Woman, one Boy (U14), and one Girl (U14). U14 means the player's birth year should be 2012 or later.
- The above condition will not be applied to national teams other than China, Kazakhstan, Mongolia, and Uzbekistan. They can have any four players.
- Discipline: International Draughts (100 square) Blitz, Rapid

# 3. SCHEDULE

5 September	Arrival Day
6 September	Opening Ceremony & Rapid Games
7 September	Blitz Games & Closing Ceremony
8 September	Back-up day
9 September	Departure Day

#### 4. TIME CONTROL OF COMPETITIONS

Rapid Games: 15min + 5secBlitz Games: 5min + 3sec

#### 5. TOURNAMENT FORMATS

- The teams play against each other for only one match by the Round Robin system. The players have orders from 1 to 4 and play against the respective players of the opponent team.
- The result of the match between the two teams will be defined by the sum of all players' game results. The winning team will have two points and both teams will win one point if the sum of individual games is 4.
- The first criterion of a tie-break between teams' results will be the sum of the winning points in all individual games. The next is the face-to-face result.
- The following criteria will be the results of the players No.1, No. 2, No. 3, and No. 4.
- The number of wins is the following criterion. Then the tiebreaker will be a super-blitz match between the teams with the time control of 5min+2sec.
- There are no duplicate places in medal qualifications.
- All other matters will be finalized at the Technical meeting
- Tournament Officials MAIN REFEREE: by ADC

#### 6. REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- 1. All entries will be received through National federations by email to <a href="mailto:office@asiadraughts.org">office@asiadraughts.org</a> or the website system. Any additional team members (coach, parents) must be included in the entry.
- 2. Registration closes on 25 June 2025.
- **3.** Only one team represents its National Federation. The host association, Japan, has a right to apply one more extra team in each discipline.
- 4. The Confederation will confirm the eligibility of the entry application.
- 5. For teams that need visas, please send the Visa Form and all passport copies to <a href="mailto:colip">coldgames@hotmail.co.jp</a> (Japan Checkers Draughts Association) as soon as possible, before or at the latest on **25 June 2025**.

# 7. TRAVEL DETAILS

 Unfortunately, the Japan Association cannot provide airport pick-up and drop-off services. We would appreciate it if each participating country could receive support from its compatriots living in Japan. However, all teams must send their travel information to the organizers to book the accommodation.

# 8. ACCOMMODATION

- The cost is expected to be \$50 per person per night.
- All other costs during the stay should be covered by the national teams.

## 9. PRIZES

• The top three teams in each championship discipline will be awarded medals and diplomas from the Confederation.

## 10. FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

• All teams, players, and officials should be responsible for their corresponding expenses such as travel, accommodation, boarding, and spending during the championship.
